

Balloons



Age of participants

From 8 years old

Number of participants

Starting with 6

Description

Players stand in a tight circle facing inwards. The game leader passes through the circle and places a balloon between the participants' heads. The players must stand very close together so that the balloons do not fall or need the help of their hands to hold them up. The players hold each other's hands behind their backs (each player holds the hand of the second neighbor to the right/left so that the circle stays tight). The circle starts to move in one direction, first slowly, then faster and faster. The leader can command other movements: to crouch, to crouch, to stand on the peaks... . If balloons fall on the ground, the leader has the task of putting them back in their place. But it can also be played in such a way that the people who drop the balloons get out of the game, with the last three left in the circle being the winners.

Materials

One balloon per 2 participants
