Satan, the father of lies

- John 8:44 J
- es. 28, 15 and Jer. 13, 25-27: we prefer lies to truth
- The fruits are visible: broken relationships, war, brutality, twisting, ...
- Fatherless society: see text! See children's movies (no positive role models!)
- Father of Lies is not a caricature, not a monster movie but naked, hard reality! We are slaves to sin, prisoners of Satan!

Will you continue to be a child of this Father? God, the true Father of love

- Jesus came to show us the Father (John 17:25-26)
- No one deserves to be called Father but God alone (Eph. 3:14f and 4.6)

Who is He:

- The Father who begat us (Jn. 3:3-6 / 2 Cor. 5:7 / Rom. 7:6
- Owner of all, giveth gladly (Ezek. 11:19 + 18:31)
- Educator (Heb. 12:4-11) Caretaker, Provider (Luke 11:1-13)
- Protector (Heb. 11)L
- Loving (John 17)
- Healing, good hands, salvation for soul, body and spirit

- Absolutely reliable
- Perfect, holy, and righteous
- Eternally the same, constant, faithful
- Good, merciful, long-suffering

- Romantic, rapturous, jealous, tender, sensitive, compassionate
- Sociable

Deep within all of us is this cry for the Father's love. We have a great longing for our hearts to be satisfied by the Father's love.

Satan is always trying to separate us from the Father. He is a master of lies. Always he denies the Father with us and raises doubts in our hearts.

Jesus had a great desire to show us the true Father. The cross means: you can come to the Father's heart from nothing else but grace alone. With Jesus the new image of the Father came into the world: "full of grace and truth" (Jn 1:14).

Quotes

"The only lesson you need to learn is that grace is grace. You can't earn my grace. And if I've decided I need you guy, if I want you as my son, then that's what I've decided - not you!" (1, p. 20)

"I love you not because you're such a decent guy, because you're ..., - but I love you because I chose to love you!" (1, p. 20)

"But what pride there is in us! We're trimmed for achievement, and we're still under the impression that "I want to produce something so I won't be totally dependent on God's grace!" (1, p. 21)

"He who seeks God no longer punishes him for sin - cf. Isa. 53:5!" (1, p. 21)

"If I want to break through to fatherhood, I must first be *ready to be a child*! A child is dependent on his father." (1, p. 22)

"Our only security is the Fatherhood of God!" (1, p. 23) - cf. Mat. 18:3

"God is often a God of the last minute (cf. Mat. 14:31)" (1, p. 23)

"God sometimes lets you get into trouble because He wants to build you up in your deep trust." "If we want to honor God with anything, it is with our child's trust in the Father." (I, p. 25)

"The goal is for the Father to become Father over this world again." (1, p. 25)

"It is important, however, to recognize Him in order to be able to love Him!" (2, p. 20)

Things are more important than children! Not with God: "The greatest evidence of God's fatherly heart is probably shown in his interest in the details of our lives. He delights to surprise us with those little pleasures and precious things that only a Father knows we crave. God is not stingy, possessive, or materialistically minded." (2, p. 24)
