

Indian Eye



Data:

- Age group 7 to 14
- A suitable location that is early and clean
- 1-2 leaders
- Up to 25 min.

Materials:

- Show Start Cords
- Prefix no matter what

Rules:

Children line up behind the rope to start. A leader or a volunteer stands at a distance in front of them, who must have their back to them. Behind this person place the object you have prepared where he/she will not see it on the ground. When the game starts the person who has their back to the others should say "Indian Eye 1,2,3, stop". During this time the children walk forward. When the person with their back to them says "stop" they turn around. The children during this time should stop in place and freeze. If anyone is seen while moving they must return to the starting line.

Target:

The object of the game is for the children to reach the object, pick it up, and return without being revealed who the object is in. If the person counting guesses the game starts again.
