The circle bundle is a **knot** used to connect two bars that are perpendicular to each other.

Prerequisites: **Mast throw**, **Samaritan**

Instruction

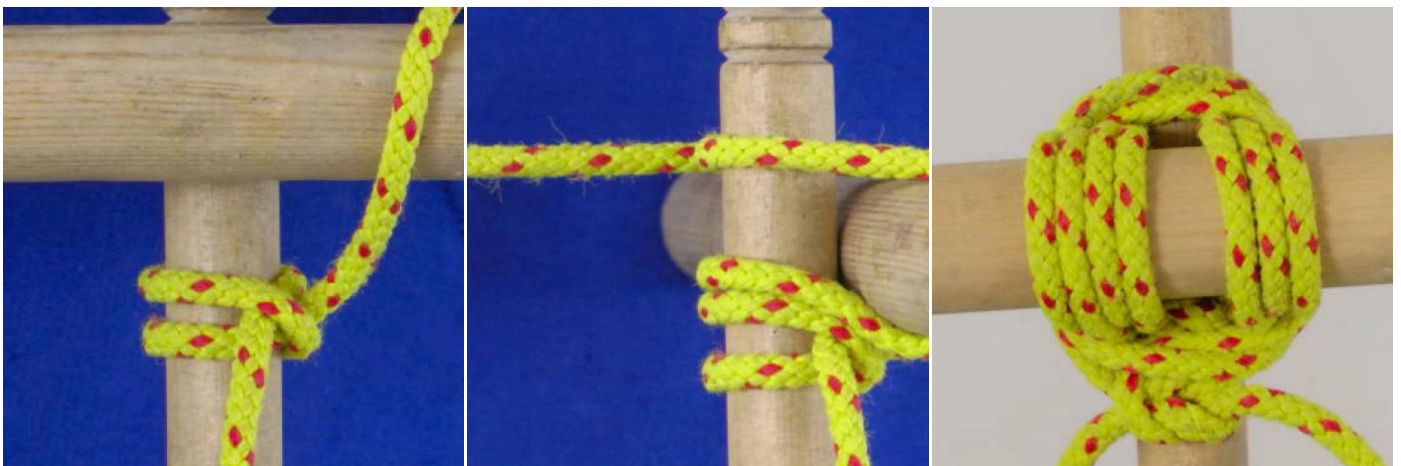
Throw the mast around the first rod. One end should be approx. 30 cm long, the other the rest.

- Use the long end to go around both poles (as shown in the video)
- After a sufficient number of rounds, the bundles are tied together
- The two ends of the rope are tied together with a Samaritan.

Tips and tricks

- If a relatively thin rope (or even cord) is used and more turns are made, the rigidity of the connection can be increased.
- If the wooden members are notched or flattened at the contact surface, the connection also becomes more stable.
