

# Javelin



How to make a spear that matches the Roman cladding.

## Material

- Wooden slats
- 3-layer boards or Pawatex boards (box back panels)
- Hammered cord
- Glue
- small nails
- Hammer
- Saw (jigsaw and handsaw)
- Silver spray
- Rasp and file

## Manufacture

- Saw off the wooden slats to the correct length.
- Saw out spearheads from the 3-layer boards or pavatex boards and spray them with silver spray.
- Saw a cut at one end of the slat for the spearhead.
- **Caution, this process is quite dangerous as you have to saw against your hand and may only be carried out by an experienced leader!**
- Insert the spearhead into the slot and secure it with the small nails.
- Wrap the cord around the batten under the spearhead and glue it in place.
- Optionally, the handle or the whole pole can be rounded off with a file and rasp.
