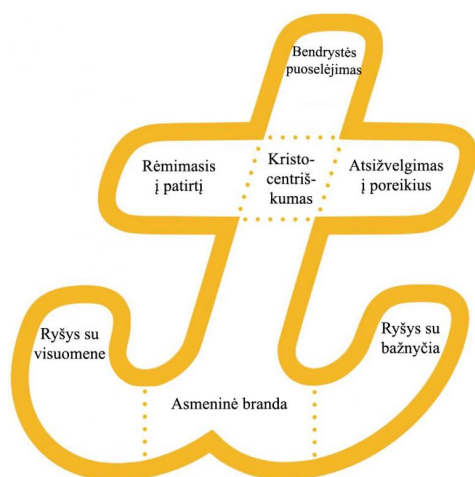


Youngstars' Values
