

Carry out storage ecologically



What ecological aspects should be considered in a warehouse? This article provides some tips.

Waste

- Build a compost hole (fill in at the end of the store)
- Separate waste: Dispose of used glass, sheet steel, pet and waste paper (observe local conditions)
- Avoid aluminum packaging
- Food waste can often be used as pig feed

Trees

- Never hammer nails into trees
- Protect trees from rope pressure points
- Do not chop or fell trees

Fireplaces

- Create fireplaces in a sensible location and of a reasonable size

Fields

- Do not walk through tall grass
- Use existing paths
- Mark out the campsite with barrier tape
- Move game objects, such as goals, several times (to protect the grass)

Detergent

- Use biodegradable cleaning products
- Use refill packs (less waste)
- Do not pour into open water

Timber

- Wood for **camp buildings** should come from the camp region
- It may be possible to take timber from a previously present group

Food

- Consider small, local stores
- Give preference to seasonal products
- Shop with a handcart

Arrival/Departure

- Use public transportation
